




ROSARY

SAINT OF THE WEEK St Thérèse of Lisieux (1873 – 1897) men

On October 1 the Church celebrates the feast day of St. Therese of Lisieux, a French Catholic Carmelite nun who is widely venerated in modern times. She is popularly known in English as the Little Flower of Jesus, or simply the Little Flower.

St. Therese had a simple yet powerful message that still resonates in the hearts of millions today. Her "Little Way" of allowing God to work through her life has become a guiding light for the faithful.



She died at the age of 24 from tuberculosis, believing that her life was really just beginning for God, promising to spend her heaven doing good on earth. Her promised "Shower of Roses" began and has become a torrent in the Church ever since. She was beatified on 29 April 1923.
