



SAINT OF THE WEEK St Vincent de Paul (1581 - 1660) 3000c

On Sept 27 the Church celebrates the feast day of St. Vincent de Paul, a French Catholic priest who dedicated himself to serving the poor. The patron saint of charitable societies, he is primarily

recognized for his charity and compassion for the poor, though he is also known for his reform of the clergy. He founded the Congregation of the Mission in 1625 and with St. Louise de Marillac he cofounded the Daughters of Charity in 1633. The Society of St. Vincent



de Paul, a Catholic charitable organization dedicated to the service of the poor, was founded by Blessed Antoine Frédéric Ozanam in 1833. Vincent was canonized in 1737 and is venerated as a saint in both the Catholic Church and the Anglican Communion.
