It is now almost 25 years since we started this fair here on Shanliss Way, and we are very thankful to all our friends and families and wonderful neighbours, friends, and families for all their great support all these years for the Capuchin Day Centre for Homeless people. Last year our numbers were around 6,900 per week. This year this has increased to 7,300. In addition to this we give out around 1,900 food parcels per week.

Please come to our summer fair on the 8th of July 2023, feel free to bring your friends to help us raise funds to keep this very important lifeline open for the many men, women and children who come to the centre on a daily basis for their meals.

Our motto is "Nobody Goes Hungry". We look forward to welcoming you all on the 8th of July to have a nice day with us. Hopefully we will have a sunny day, which would be great!
